

Chalk Art Transfer Tips

Supplies

- Chalkboard (Non-porous: porcelain, PVC, acrylic, slate)
- Ordinary chalk (Crayola Anti-dust is my favorite)
- Chalk Markers (Bistro Small Size, Dual-tip Crafty Craft)
- Old rags (as erasers) & Q-tips (for close-work erasing)
- Container of water (for wetting rags/Q-tips as needed)
- 2-hole sharpener
- Pencil

General tips

- Season new chalkboards by rubbing chalk over the entire surface.
- Press lightly with markers

Transfer process

1. Size and print artwork.
2. Chalk the back of your art.
3. Tape art to board.
4. Trace the front of your art to leave chalk outlines on board.
5. Dab-erase chalk lines before tracing with marker.
6. When outline is dry, erase chalk lines completely.
7. Detail with chalk and markers.
8. Add embellishments and details as desired.
